Managing Household Hazardous Waste

What is Household Hazardous Waste?



CORROSIVE

Batteries
Drain Cleaners
Oven Cleaners



Pre-plan for your projects.

Buy the smallest amount needed to get the job done

TOXIC

Pesticides
Rat Poison
Pharmaceuticals
Cleaning Fluids



Buy a potentially less hazardous alternative to your desired HHW
I.E– Baking soda and Vinegar for cooking



REACTIVE

Pool Chemicals
Ammonia
Bleach
Aerosols



Always read the label before buying a product to be sure it will meet your needs. (keep the labels on all of the containers and carefully follow all the directions when using the hazardous products

FLAMMABLE

Paints, Solvents
Oils, Gasoline
BBQ Starter
Propane Cylinder



Use all the product for its intended use. You can also share or donate your leftover materials with someone else that may have a need for the unused product.

DON'T

Dispose of materials into the storm sewer or septic systems.

Don't burn or bury leftover materials or containers.

Don't mix materials together.

Household hazardous waste is defined as products that can catch fire, react, or explode under certain circumstances, or that are corrosive or toxic. To avoid negative exposure to the HHW, it is important for you to monitor the use and storage of the product, as well as the safe disposal. HHW can have very negative effects on human health that include: behavioral abnormalities, cancer, genetic mutations, physical deformations, etc. We want individuals to have every opportunity to avoid said side effects associated with improper use. Safe disposal is also important, as the introduction of noxious chemicals into our natural environment can have detrimental effects on our waterways, clean drinking water, and other natural processes.
